Estate grown, single vineyard.

Sustainable vineyard management and 100% hand picked. Bunch sorted, 50% destemmed, 50% whole bunch pressed. Wild fermentation in French barriques (20% new, 80% older). Matured in barrel on lees for nine months.

100% malolactic fermentation.

Lightly fined and filtered before bottling. Vegan.

TASTING NOTES

Nose: Lemon curd, grapefruit and apple are coupled with flintiness and white floral notes.

Palate: Marzipan, sherbet, lime zest and minerality. A gentle creaminess gives way to some lovely mid palate depth and a gentle smooth finish. Definitely, a wine to sit down and enjoy with some delicious food.

SEASON

The start of the 2023 growing season was exceedingly wet, delaying budburst substantially, which had a knock-on effect across every stage of the vine development. However, the extra rain also helped in setting some great fruit and our vineyards had never looked so healthy. In contrast to our record-breaking rainfall in October 2022, January and February were some of the driest months we've had in years. This had a further impact on vine development, particularly when coupled with some unseasonably cool days throughout the peak of summer. Ultimately, we ended up with a cool but steady end of season, with some later rain events. We recorded our latest picks on record.
