VINES

VINIFICATION

Estate grown, single vineyard.

Sustainable vineyard management and 100% hand picked.

Bunch sorted and 40% of fruit destemmed and held on skins for six hours before gentle pressing. The remaining 60% was whole bunch pressed. Both components were settled overnight before racking with lees into old French barriques for partial wild fermentation.

Matured for three months in old French oak.

Racked and lightly fined and filtered before bottling. Vegan.

TASTING NOTES

Nose: Lemon sherbet, green apple with honeysuckle and jasmine florals. Palate: Racy acidity coupled with great length and breadth. An incredibly textured wine. Apricot and lemon curd.

SEASON

The start of the 2023 growing season was exceedingly wet, delaying budburst substantially, which had a knock-on effect across every stage of the vine development. However, the extra rain also helped in setting some great fruit and our vineyards had never looked so healthy. In contrast to our record-breaking rainfall in October 2022, January and February were some of the driest months we've had in years. This had a further impact on vine development, particularly when coupled with some unseasonably cool days throughout the peak of summer. Ultimately we ended up with a cool but steady end of season, with some later rain events. We recorded our latest picks on record.
